I am a London-based technology professional with practical experience across computer networks and security, iOS engineering, full-stack development, website support and operational environments. I hold an MSc in Computer Networks and Security from the University of Essex, awarded with Merit, and a BSc (Hons) in Computer Science with a Year in Industry from the University of Kent. I am particularly drawn to work where secure thinking, dependable delivery and continuous learning matter.

During my iOS Developer/Engineer experience at Information Technology Consultants, I worked with Swift, UIKit, SwiftUI, REST APIs, data storage, testing and Agile delivery. Earlier, I completed more than 400 hours of full-stack training and built database-driven applications using HTML, CSS, JavaScript, PHP, Python, SQL and APIs. At Leigh Academies Trust, I supported more than 30 education websites, handled technical requests, analysed site performance and collaborated with IT, design, marketing and management colleagues.

I have gained experience from outside the working environment by becoming a regular member of the 'AI, Founders, Crypto, NFT, Web3, Sustainability, FinTech Networking' event in London, which has exposed me to various forms of business, communication and individuals with shared motives and goals. The event has also allowed me to develop communication and networking skills, increasing my reach to new projects and opportunities.

My portfolio demonstrates how I apply these skills independently. I designed APIShield+, a cloud-native API security platform using authentication, access controls, anomaly detection, audit logging, Docker and Kubernetes. I am also developing Multi-Planner, a modular SwiftUI productivity application with secure cross-device backup through Supabase. Alongside these larger projects, I build smaller web and mobile projects to explore APIs, interface ideas and new programming techniques.

There is more to my work than the technical detail on my CV. In 2024, I self-published my adventure and action book, *The Lost Legacy: Echoes of Deception*. Taking it from an idea to a completed publication strengthened my research, creativity, written communication, planning and perseverance. I also attend technology and professional-development events to learn from others, follow industry developments and build confidence in professional conversations.

I hold a swimming licence and have swum regularly for more than 15 years, which reflects discipline, consistency and commitment to personal well-being. My operational experience in warehouse, forklift and material-handling roles has further strengthened my safety awareness, accuracy, reliability and ability to remain calm while working at pace.
